1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W6283/2019/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the Existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Works Approval W6283/2019/1 is held by Talison Lithium Australia Pty Ltd (Works Approval Holder) for the Talison Lithium Mine (the Premises), located along Maranup Ford Road, Greenbushes, Western Australia 6254. The premises is located on parts of mining tenements M01/3, M01/6, M01/7, M01/8, M01/9, M1/16 and general purpose leases G01/1, G01/04,

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W6283/2019/1.

The department has initiated an amendment to Works Approval W6283/2019/1. The amendment is limited to removing dust monitoring conditions and infrastructure that will be transferred to the premises operating licence L4247/1991/13.

3. Consultation

The Works Approval Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 26 May 2023. On 21 June 2023 the Works Approval Holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.
