1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W6426/2020/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the Existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

2.2 Application summary

Works Approval W6426/2020/1 is held by Greenstone Resources (WA) Pty Ltd (Works Approval Holder) for the King of the Hill (KOTH) Gold Mine (the Premises), located on Mining Tenements M37/67, M37/76, M37/90, M37/201, M37/222, M37/248, M37/330, M37/410, M37/429, M37/449, M37/451, M37/457, M37/547, M37/548, M37/572, M37/573, M37/574 and M37/1105.

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W6426/2020/1.

On 19 September 2022, the Works Approval Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Works Approval W6426/2020/1 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to the continuation of time limited operations (TLO) for the Tailings Storage Facility 4 (TSF4) past the specified 180 calendar days. The Critical Containment Infrastructure Report (CCIR) for the TSF4 was submitted on the 23 March 2022. A response from the department advising compliance and the commencement of TLO was provided to the Works Approval Holder on the 11 April 2022. In complying with old works approval condition 19, the end of TLO for TSF4 would be 8 October 2022. The Works Approval Holder has sought out the approval to extend the TLO to match that of the processing plant so operations may continue until such time that an assessment and determination of subsequent licence amendment application for L8345/2009/2 can be authorised by the department. This amendment to W6426/2020/1 will extend the duration of authorised TLO for TSF4 from 180 calendar days to 243 calendar days to end on the 10 December 2022.

The items of infrastructure that are authorised under the works approval and have commenced TLO, are presented in Table 1.

In the amendment to the works approval, the CEO has also corrected minor clerical mistakes within the instrument.

3. Consultation

The Works Approval Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 12 October 2022. On 12 October 2022, the Works Approval Holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised works approval as part of the amendment process.
