1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W6540/2021/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The Decision Report for the existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Application summary

Works Approval W6540/2021/1 is held by Paddington Gold Pty Ltd trading as Norton Gold Fields Pty Ltd (Works Approval Holder) for the Rose Pit Landfill (the Premises), located at part of Mining Tenement M24/82, Mount Pleasant WA 6431.

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the Environmental Protection Regulations 1987 (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W6540/2021/1.

On 27 March 2026, the Works Approval Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Works Approval W6540/2021/1 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to extending the works approval expiry date by two years, from 22 July 2026 to 22 July 2028. This is to allow for the construction of the landfill trenches, which has not yet commenced, and to allow sufficient time for time limited operations to be undertaken at the landfill trenches, once constructed.

The design and operational aspects of the landfill trenches, as well as the requirements under the existing works approval, including duration authorised for time limited operation, remain unchanged. As such, the risk assessment outlined in the Decision Report for the existing works approval remains relevant. No updated risk assessment is required.

3. Consultation

The Works Approval Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 21 April 2026. On 21 April 2026, the Works Approval Holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

approval as part of the amendment process.
