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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W6592/2021/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In completing the assessment documented in this Amendment Report, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

2.2 Amendment summary

Works Approval W6592/2021/1 is held by CPB Contractors Pty Ltd (Works Approval Holder) for the Yanchep Rail Extension (the Premises), located at 146K Torepango Avenue Yanchep Western Australia, 6035.

The Premises relates to category 12 to screen sand on site and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W6592/2021/1.

On 31 March 2023 the Works Approval Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Works Approval W6592/2021/1 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to extensions of Time Limited Operations for an additional 90 days while the associated licence application progresses to authorise ongoing operations and for inclusion of prescribed premises category 13 (crushing).

With the amendment being administrative in nature and does not change the risk profile of premises.

2.3 **Operations under Time Limited Operations**

Sand screening operations activities includes the following:

- crushing and screening of sand
- handling and stockpiling of material including loading of material into trucks
- vehicle movements; and
- refueling (via refueling truck equipped with a spill kit and drip tray).

Operating hours occur between 7 am and 7 pm Monday to Saturday. Operations exclude Sundays and public holidays.

3. Consultation

The Works Approval Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 19 April 2023. The Works Approval Holder responded on 19 April 2023 to waive the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 7 provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised Works Approval as part of the amendment process.
