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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W6623/2021/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the Existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

2.2 Application summary

Works Approval W6623/2021/1 is held by Pilbara Iron Company (Services) Pty Ltd (Works Approval Holder) for the Paraburdoo Iron Ore Mine and Eastern Range Project (the Premises), located at Rocklea within the Shire of Ashburton.

The Premises relates to categories 54 (Sewage facility) and 73 (Bulk storage of chemicals, etc.) and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations* 1987 (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W6623/2021/1.

On 4 May 2023, the Works Approval Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Works Approval W6623/2021/1 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act* 1986 (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to amending commissioning conditions 5, 9 and 12:

- Condition 5 Consolidating wet and biological commissioning into a single commissioning period and increasing total aggregate commissioning to 180 days.
- Condition 9 Specify Category 54 for the commissioning report. Bulk fuel infrastructure (Category 73) does not require commissioning.
- Condition 12 Inclusion of 'items' in reference to Skids 1, 2 and 3, which may be commissioned together or individually. Inclusion of 'whichever is sooner' in reference to conditions 12(a) and 12(b).

3. Consultation

The Works Approval Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 30 August 2023. Comments received from the Works Approval Holder on 15 September 2023 and 19 September 2023 have been considered by the Delegated Officer as detailed in Appendix 1.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised works approval as part of the amendment process.
