1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to transfer works approval W6641/2022/1 from the existing licence holder (Iluka Resources Limited) to Iluka Rare Earths Pty Ltd (the applicant).

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In completing the assessment documented in this decision report, the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (the department; DWER) has considered and given due regard to its regulatory framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

2.2 Application summary and overview of premises

Iluka Resources Limited currently holds works approval W6641/2022/1 for the operation of Eneabba Mineral Sands Mine (the premises), located in Eneabba as Part of Mining Lease M267SA.

On 14 December 2022, Iluka Rare Earths Pty Ltd submitted an application to the department to transfer works approval W6641/2022/1 under section 64 of the EP Act. The application is limited to transferring the works approval holder details, including the works approval holder name, ACN and registered address.

Boundary Changes

The applicant is undergoing a corporate re-organisation is as a result of a Loan Agreement with Export Finance Australia. As a consequence of the restructure, Iluka Eneabba Ltd will be the holder of ML 267SA (State Agreement), M70/879 (Mining Act) and M70/821 (Mining Act); and Iluka Rare Earths Ltd will hold a sublease over part of ML 262SA and M70/821 which will cover the infrastructure authorised for construction and time limited operations under W6641/2022/1. The applicant has applied for the premises boundary of W6641/2022/1 to align with the boundary of the land subject to the sublease. No new construction or operations are proposed for this works approval and any changes are administrative only in nature.

3. Assessment

The assessment of transfer applications requires the determination of whether the new occupier meets the Department's fitness and competency requirements. Further, the applicant must provide documentary evidence of the date they became occupier of the premises.

Legal entity and occupancy status

The applicant is a registered company with a valid and current entry on the Australian Securities & Investments Commission register (ACN 654 487 662) and is therefore a legal entity. The applicant holds a sublease over part of ML 262SA and M70/821.

Fitness and competency

The applicant advises it has not been convicted or paid a penalty for an offence under a provision of the EP Act or its subsidiary legislation or similar environmental protection legislation in Australia.

4. Decision

The Delegated Officer has determined to transfer works approval W6641/2022/1 to Iluka Rare Earths Pty Ltd on the grounds it is a current legal entity with legal access to the premises and

has no known convictions.

5. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this transfer report, the Delegated Officer determined to transfer the works approval to Iluka Rare Earths Pty Ltd.
