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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W6664/2022/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

2.2 Amendment summary

Works Approval W6664/2022/1 is held by Fortescue Ltd (Works Approval Holder) for the Eliwana Flying Fish Camp WWTP (the Premises), located as part of Mining Tenement M47/1509, Tom Price, WA, 6751.

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W6664/2022/1 and Table 1 below.

Table 1: Approved production capacity

Category 54: Sewage facility: premises – (a) on which sewage is treated (excluding septic tanks); or (b) from which treated sewage is discharged onto land or into waters	Not more than 114 cubic metres per day

On 17 April 2025, the Works Approval Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Works Approval W6664/2022/1 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to extending the duration of time limited operations for an additional 180 days.

The current duration of time limited operations is for 180 days. The Works Approval Holder wishes to extend this duration to facilitate the incorporation of the works approved under Works Approval W6664/2022/1 into the Licence L9221/2019/1.

During assessment it was noted the occupier's company name and company address registered with ASIC differed to that shown on the works approval. As such the Works Approval Holder has taken this opportunity to also amend these details.

3. Consultation

The Works Approval Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 30 May 2025. The Works Approval Holder advised on 5 June 2025 they have no further comments and would like to waive the remaining consultation period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 2 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised works approval as part of the amendment process.
