Amendment summary

Background

Works approval W6669/2022/1 is held by Yuri Operations Pty Ltd (works approval holder) for Project Yuri (the premises), located at Part of Lot 564 on Deposited Plan 31023, Village Road, Burrup WA, 6714.

The works approval relates to the construction and time limited operations of a renewable hydrogen production plant about 9 km northwest of Dampier. The premises relates to category 31- chemical manufacturing with an assessed production capacity of 640 tonnes per annual period under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing works approval W6669/2022/1.

Works approval amendment

The works approval was issued on 18 August 2022 and an amendment to the works approval for an extension to the expiry date was granted on 15 July 2025. The amended works approval was issued without a signature block name and date, therefore the delegated officer determined to amend the works approval under section 59(1) of the EP Act, to ensure it is appropriately signed and dated.

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its regulatory framework and relevant policy documents available at <http://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

Decision

The delegated officer has determined to grant replacement works approval W6669/2022/1 with administrative changes and without conducting any additional assessment, on the grounds that the risk profile of the construction and time limited operations will not change, and it does not change the obligations of the works approval holder.

In replacing the existing works approval, the delegated officer has determined to:

- update the signature and dates, and
- transfer all existing regulatory controls and conditions to the replacement works approval.

The decision report for the existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision-making.

Consultation

The works approval holder was provided with drafts of the amended works approval and this report on 3 December 2025. The works approval holder responded on the 4 December 2025 and waived the comment period and provided no comments.

Conclusion

The delegated officer has determined to amend the existing works approval, subject to conditions, commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administrative and reporting requirements.
