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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W6723. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Application summary

Works Approval W6723 is held by Onslow Infracore Pty Ltd (Works Approval Holder) for the North West Coastal Highway Temporary Camp (the Premises), located at Miscellaneous licenses L08/205, L08/215 and L08/216 Pastoral lease 3114/905 PEEDAMULLA WA.

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W6723.

On 11 March 2024, the Works Approval Holder submitted an application to the department to amend works approval W6723 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to extending time limited operations duration for an additional 119 days (to 15 October 2024) to allow sufficient time for stage 2 of the WWTP to lodge a commissioning report, followed by an application for a licence for stages 1 and 2 to be submitted and assessed by the department.

Time limited operations (duration of 180 calendar days) commenced on 21 December 2023 when the Environmental Compliance Report (ECR) for Stage 1 of the WWTP was submitted to the department for assessment. The currently authorised time limited operations expire on the 18 June 2024. This amendment will extend time limited operations from 180 days to 299 days, expiring on 15 October 2024.

The Works Approval Holder has advised the department that a licence application will be prepared and lodged for both stages, once Stage 2 has demonstrated compliance with environmental commissioning conditions detailed in W6723.

3. Consultation

The Works Approval Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 19 April 2024. The Works Approval Holder waived the consultation period on 22 April 2024 and requested the amendment be finalised.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised Works Approval as part of the amendment process.
