1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W6835/2023/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged. This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the Existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <u>https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents</u>.

2.2 Application summary

Works Approval W6835/2023/1 is held by Talison Lithium Australia Pty Ltd (Works Approval Holder) for the Old Mill Road Workers Camp (the Premises), located at 75 Old Mill Road, North Greenbushes

The Premises relates to the Category 85: Sewerage facility and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W6835/2023/1.

On 16 December 2024, the Works Approval Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Works Approval W6835/2023/1 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to extending the works approval Time Limited Operations (TLO) phase from 180 calendar days to 360 calendar days to allow for the performance of the plant to stabilise (post commissioning and engineering refinement).

The premises is currently in the TLO phase and is due to end on the 6 January 2025. The proposed extension of TLO by an additional 180 calendar days results in a new end date of 6 July 2025.

3. Consultation

On 19 December 2024 the Works Approval Holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised works approval as part of the amendment process.
