Negligible environmental impact is suspected. Ongoing operational and regulatory sampling has confirmed that TN has returned within licence limits. Groundwater continued to be monitored via a network of site monitoring bores and no issues were identified.						
Cause (or suspecte	ed cause) of non-compliance:					
Due to the scheduled project upgrade works, the Gordon Road treatment facility was only running two of the three oxidation ditches and one of the two Dissolved Air Flotation Tanks (DAFTs). Normally this situation is sufficient to treat, however when combined with ongoing faults of the second DAFT, the solids load had increased, resulting in nitrogen removal being constrained. Subsequently, elevated levels of total nitrogen were discharged to the infiltration ponds.						
Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:						
Both DAFTs have since been repaired and are operating as expected. TN concentrations have returned to within licence limits.
