Underperforming nitrification and denitrification of treatment ponds 2,3 and 4. Undersized aeration technology for pond 3 with accumulation of pond sludge reducing hydraulic retention time, reducing treatment efficiency.				
Reduced daily water usage, increasing nutrient concentration of initial effluent, increasing stress placed on wastewater treatment plant.				
Inability to use irrigation area L4 during quarter 1 and 2 for animal welfare purposes of holding stock unable to be processed due to high COVID-19 staff infection. This resulted in increased irrigation to L1, L2 and L3 during these times.				
Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:				
Robotic desludging contractor employed to remove built up sludge in treatment ponds. Revised wastewater treatment plant upgrades to be presented in January to V&V Walsh stakeholders from design consultants. Nitrification and denitrification technology options explored for current system. Biological additives to aid in nitrogen removal to be explored in 2023. Surrounding land owners are continuing to be approached for additional irrigation areas.
