Buru Energy (Buru) updated the tank thickness inspection frequency from biennial to 5-yearly in accordance with the <i>API 653 Tank Inspection, Repair, Alteration, and Reconstruction</i> standard and the <i>Blina-Erskine Pipeline Integrity Management Plan</i> (OP-PLN-085) (PIMP), as referenced in the <i>Blina Pipeline Safety Case</i> (HSE-SC-002) approved by the Department of Energy, Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety (DEMIRS) on 12 August 2019 and revised in July 2021 under the <i>Petroleum Pipelines (Management of Safety of Pipeline Operations) Regulations 2010.</i> Integrity inspections have been undertaken in accordance with the Safety Case, PIMP and API 653. Buru however did not apply for a licence amendment from DWER for the change of inspection frequency and thus acknowledges its non-compliance with the inspection frequency stipulated in Licence L6872/1994/11.					
Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence					
of the non-compliance: As the 5-yearly tank thickness inspection frequency has been accepted in Buru's other regulatory approvals and is as per API 653, Buru will request to amend Licence L6872/1994/11 to adjust the tank thickness monitoring frequency to 5-yearly. Buru has continued to undertake routine visual inspections of tanks, and all other integrity inspections have been undertaken in accordance with L6872/1994/11.
