During an internal licence compliance audit it was observed that there was floating debris and algae at the northern end of Pond 1. What was the actual (or suspected) environmental impact of the non-compliance? NOTE - please attach maps or diagrams to provide insight into the precise location of where the noncompliance took place. No suspected environmental impact took place due to the non-compliance. Cause (or suspected cause) of non-compliance: There are no inlet screens on the inlet works at this plant allowing debris to enter the pond. Additionally, sludge build up, low winds and shallow pond contributed to this non-compliance. Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance: Desludging has been prioritised at this site for the 23-24 financial year. Additionally, investigations are underway to determine if deepening the pond will prevent further issues. Was this non-compliance previously reported to DWER?
