 This non-compliance is not suspected to have an environmental impact given the following: Busselton Golf Club operated (irrigated the golf course) within the expected design parameters for 2023-2024 reporting period. High nutrient uptake by the turf and no observed run-off from site to the nearest sensitive receptor. Nutrient loading rates for nitrogen and phosphorus were well under the licenced targets of 500kg/ha/yr and 30kg/ha/yr respectively. 					
Cause (or suspect	ed cause) of non-compliance	е:			
Irrigation water drawn from the Busselton Water Resource Recovery Facility exceeded the production / design capacity. The Busselton area in general experienced a longer, warmer summer with little to no rainfall for an almost 8 month period. Therefore, the Busselton Golf Club irrigated the golf course for an extended period of between 6-8 weeks longer than normal operations. Additional water was sourced during this reporting period.					
Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:					
Busselton Golf Club have been liaising with Water Corporation staff to closely monitor irrigation volumes, including implementing regular cross-sharing of water balance information. Busselton Golf Club will continue to optimise water usage and abstraction volumes for the 2024-2025 irrigation season.
