Minimal – the high volume of water was likely to be a result of the higher than average rainfall in winter and spring 2023 resulting in increased volumes requiring disposal. Due to relatively low nutrient concentrations in the irrigation water, the conditioned nutrient loading limits were not exceeded with less than 50% of the allowable loading applied.			
Cause (or suspecte	ed cause) of non-compliance:		
The high volume of water was likely to be a result of the higher than average rainfall in winter and spring 2021 resulting in increased volumes requiring disposal. Longer run times for operation due to staff shortages also increases water usage at the site.			
Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:			
Ensuring maximum holding capacity is available in the winter storage dam at the start of the winter period.
