Putrescible waste covered approximately quarterly, or as practical, rather than fortnightly due to minimal rubbish being deposited at the landfill and an absence of suitable machinery for this task due to the site being in care and maintenance.			
Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:			
Once the site goes into the construction phase and is producing higher amounts of waste, the waste will be covered on a fortnightly basis. Visual inspections are undertaken regularly on the landfill to confirm that no wind-blown waste has occurred.
