Evaporation Ponds pipeline flowmeter failed on the 20/01/2023 and was no longer recording discharge rates to the evaporation ponds.

EMO considers that there is no environmental impact to the area within and surrounding the evaporation ponds. In addition to routine monitoring of the evaporation pond area, groundwater levels have also seen no significant deviations in the time since non-compliance began.
