This exceedance did not result in emissions to land exceeding the emissions limits set out in the licence. In 2024, TN loading reached 128.15 kg/ha, well below the specified limit of 300 kg/ha. Similarly, TP loading stood at 38.01 kg/ha, within the defined threshold of 50 kg/ha. Additionally, BOD was recorded at 0.54 kg/ha/day, remaining comfortably below the limit of 30 kg/ha/day.

The exceedance of the production capacity can be attributed to an upsurge in processing numbers, a direct response to the escalating demand from emerging markets.						
Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:						
As noted in the previous AACR, HMP is planning to lodge a license amendment to double its production capacity, with the objective of managing the additional kills in a sustainable manner. To achieve this, liaison with consultants commenced in 2024. At this stage, we have yet to finalize a proposal with sufficient detail to present to DWER for a scoping meeting. Once the proposal is deemed robust, a scoping meeting will be organized to obtain DWER's initial feedback, which will also help guide the preparation of the application.
