non-compliance: As of 4 December 2025, the Bunbury Harvey Regional Council ceased accepting FOGO loads to				
address potential contamination of composted material identified by DWER and attempt to				
remain within our licenced acceptance limits of 20,000 tonnes per year. Councils using this				
facility were notified that BHRC was not immediately able to accept FOGO material due to high contamination levels in incoming loads. After exploring ultimately unsuccessful mitigating				
options, BHRC engaged GHD to develop a strategy to identify the contamination risk and				
determine treatment options.
