The breach, whilst a technical breach of a licence condition, did not in any way increase the risk of odour impacts from the Site given the biofilters' extremely low volumetric airflow and the existing baseline odours within the Site from compost materials and the like. The odours from the biofilter are not discernable, nor detectable within the Site.

Biofilter media was "spent" and required refurbishment/replacement to ensure a uniform and workable organic media for microbes to propagate and subsequently metabolise the odorous compounds delivered through the biofilter media.
