Annual stack Test not performed. Have confirmed Stack Test methodology with DWER and test has been booked in, to be performed by 31/03/21. Due to remoteness, weather and Covid restrictions test was finally performed on 30/03/21. Have discussed with DWER that results will follow as soon as available.

Cause (or suspected cause) of non-compliance:			
Initial stack testing during plant commissioning was deemed unacceptable by DER. Re-testing was performed and submitted at the end of 2016. KEC have been awaiting feedback to confirm stack test results are compliant prior to ordering another (rather costly) stack test. Stack test methodology was submitted to DWER and accepted. There has been difficulty getting stack testing performed in Karratha and DWER has been notified on numerous occasions of these delays.

<p>There is no direct adverse effect from the stack test not being performed. It is performed for monitoring purposes. There have been no malfunctions with the baghouse operation to suggest there would be any breach of monitored emission standards. Stack tests will now be performed on a yearly basis as per licence conditions. They have been included on the Company ITP register.</p>




