No environmental impact has occurred due to the monitoring that was missed during the reporting period. A substantial dataset has been collected from the site that includes 7 quarters of lab results and monthly SWLs from all primary bores at monitoring locations across the site. The existing dataset is adequate to trend data and provide a summary of groundwater conditions at the site.				
Cause (or suspecte	ed cause) of non-compliance:			
New ownership and high staff turnover are the primary reason for the omission of the Q4 2022 monitoring period and SWL readings over the reporting period. Since Karora took ownership of the Lakewood GPF from Golden Mile Milling Pty Ltd on 27th of July 2022 there has been an 83% turnaround in staff at the facility. Furthermore, existing contracts were in place for groundwater monitoring with a reputable consulting firm which stated monitoring to be undertaken in compliance with Licence L9124. Mistakenly, Karora was under the impression that the monitoring was being conducted in line with the Licence conditions. New management and the implementation of monitoring procedures at Lakewood will ensure that Karora remain in compliance with monitoring requirements as prescribed in Licence L9124.				
Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the				
Narora no completes the monthly and quarterly monitoring internally and is the sole responsibility of the Environment Department. Environment Department staff have the correct equipment, resources and a thorough understanding of monitoring commitments in the L9124/2018/1. An updated monitoring procedure is being developed for the Lakewood site and additional monitoring equipment has been purchased to ensure the work can be conducted efficiently removing the reliance on external contractors. Karora also holds Part V Licences for Avoca Mining Pty Ltd and Salt Lake Pty Ltd. Since taking ownership of these facilities, Karora lifted work standards and infrastructure managed under Part V of the EP Act. These facilities are in good-standing with reporting requirements and DWER.
