- (d) any reference to an Australian or other standard, guideline or code of practice in this Works Approval means the version of the standard, guideline or code of practice in force at the time of granting of this Works Approval and includes any amendments to the standard, guideline or code of practice which may occur from time to time during the course of the Works Approval; and
- (e) unless specified otherwise, any reference to a section of an Act refers to that section of the EP Act.

NOTE: This works approval requires specific conditions to be met but does not provide any implied authorisation for other emissions, discharges, or activities not specified in this works approval.

Works approval conditions

Construction phase

Infrastructure and equipment

- 1** The Works Approval Holder must:
 - (a) construct and/or install the infrastructure and/or equipment;
 - (b) in accordance with the corresponding design and construction / installation requirements; and
 - (c) at the corresponding infrastructure location;as set out in Table 1.
- 2** The Works Approval Holder must not depart from the requirements specified in Table 1 except:
 - (a) where such departure does not increase risks to public health, public amenity or the environment; and
 - (b) all other conditions in this Works Approval are still satisfied.

Compliance reporting

- 3** Subject to Condition 1, within 30 days of the completion of the Works specified in Table 1, the Works Approval Holder must provide to the CEO a report from a suitably qualified person and/or employee of the Works Approval Holder, confirming each item of infrastructure or component of infrastructure specified in Table 1 has been constructed with no material defects and to the requirements specified in Table 1.
- 4** Where a departure from the requirements specified in Table 1 occurs and is of a type allowed by Condition 2, the Works Approval Holder must provide to the CEO a description of, and explanation for, the departure along with the certification required

by Condition 3.

Time limited operations phase

- 5** The Works Approval Holder may conduct time limited operations of the mobile crushing and screening plant and Category 12 operations, within the premises boundary:
- (a) for a period not exceeding 90 calendar days from the day the Works Approval Holder meets the requirements of Condition 3; or
 - (b) until such time as a licence for that item of infrastructure is granted in accordance with Part V of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*, if one is granted before the end of the period specified in condition 5(a).
- 6** The Works Approval Holder must ensure that no visible dust generated from the primary activities crosses the boundary of the premises.

Records and reporting

- 7** The Works Approval Holder must record the following information in relation to complaints received by the Works Approval Holder (whether received directly from a complainant or forwarded to them by the Department or another party) about any alleged emissions from the premises:
- (a) the name and contact details of the complainant, (if provided);
 - (b) the time and date of the complaint;
 - (c) the complete details of the complaint and any other concerns or other issues raised; and
 - (d) the complete details and dates of any action taken by the Works Approval Holder to investigate or respond to any complaint.
- 8** The Works Approval Holder must maintain accurate and auditable books including the following records, information, reports and data required by this works approval:
- (a) the works conducted in accordance with condition 1;
 - (b) any maintenance of infrastructure that is performed in the course of complying with condition 1; and
 - (c) complaints received under condition 7.
- 9** The books specified under condition 8 must:
- (a) be legible;
 - (b) if amended, be amended in such a way that the original version(s) and any subsequent amendments remain legible and are capable of retrieval;
 - (c) be retained by the works approval holder for the duration of the works approval; and
 - (d) be available to be produced to an inspector or the CEO as required.

Definitions

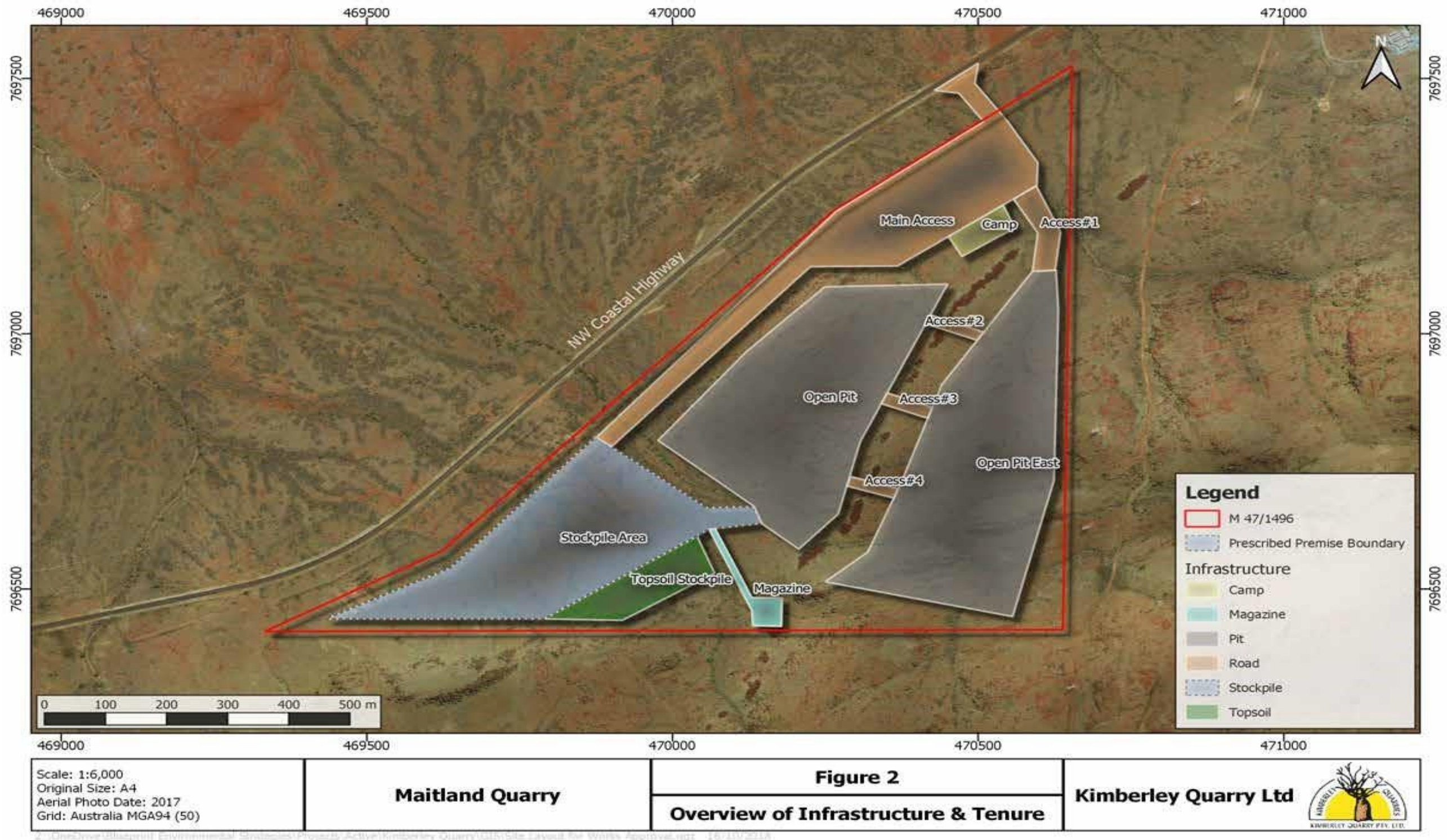


Figure 1: Map of the boundary of the prescribed premises

premises	refers to the premises to which this Works Approval applies, as specified at the front of this Works Approval and as shown on the premises map (Figure 1) in Schedule 1 to this Works Approval.
prescribed premises	has the same meaning given to that term under the EP Act.
time limited operations	refers to the operation of the infrastructure and equipment identified under this works approval that is authorised for that purpose, subject to the relevant conditions.
Works	refers to the Works described in Schedule 2, at the locations shown in Schedule 1 of this Works Approval to be carried out at the Premises, subject to the Conditions.
Works Approval	refers to this document, which evidences the grant of the works approval by the CEO under s.54 of the EP Act, subject to the conditions.

The boundary of the prescribed premises is shown in the map below (Figure 1).
